

KIDS KORNER RULES and POLICIES

These rules and policies have been established for the benefit and safety of your child and in response to the Summit County Health Department's Day Care Responsible Restart Ohio Standards. While our staff is certified in Red Cross First Aid/CPR as well and background checked, our facility is not a licensed daycare. We are not equipped to provide one-on-one care for children of any age. By following these rules, you can greatly help insure the safety of all our children.

- Kids Korner is available for children 6 weeks – 7 years of age.
- The maximum capacity is not 18 children at one time (first-come, first-serve).
- Kids Korner is available ONLY to members' children and grandchildren. Children of Non-members & guests will be assessed a guest fee \$5 per child to use childcare.
- Parents and Guardians are required to remain on premises while children are in Kids Korner.
- Only one parent can check in/check out their child in the Kids Korner.
- Children are strongly encouraged to wash/sanitize their hands upon arrival. Our illness policy will be **STRICTLY ENFORCED** (see illness policy, backside).
- Masks are optional for staff and children, ages 3 years and up.
- **NO FOOD, DRINKS OR GUM ALLOWED.**
- Toys and Electronic Devices: You may not bring into the Kids Korner any toys or electronic devices (e.g., cell phones, PSPs, Game Boys, iPods, etc.), unless there is something that your child uses for comfort being a first-timer within our Kids Korner. In those cases, please make sure to label this belonging accordingly and we do not assume any liability if this belonging becomes lost, stolen or broken.
- Children are required to wear socks while in the child care area. **NO BARE FEET.**
- Please make sure your child has a fresh diaper before dropping them off.
- You may be asked to pick up your child if they are inconsolable.
- Children with possible infectious illness should be left at home. They should not have the following within the last 24 hours: colds, runny noses with discolored mucus, pink eye, fever, diarrhea, vomiting, or any communicable illness, (ex. Chicken pox).
- If your child is home from school for illness reasons, they are not allowed to be in our Kids Korner or the club.
- There is a daily limit of 2 hours per child. You will be charged a fee of \$10 over the time limit.
- In an effort to keep a healthy and safe environment, the Kids Korner staff cleans and disinfects all toys throughout each shift. Toys will be rotated and sanitized in an organized fashion.
- Employees will follow rigorous hand washing throughout the day.
- We are not responsible for lost, broken, misplaced or stolen items.

Illness Policy

In an effort to reduce the spread of communicable diseases and germs as well as protecting our members, children and staff from illness, we will be strictly enforcing our ***Illness Policy***.

Please keep your child at home if he/she currently has, or has had within the past 24 hours, any of the following symptoms:

- Fever of 100° or higher
- Cold or cough with thick discharge
- Constant runny nose
- Croup
- Strep Throat
- Gastroenteritis (Stomach Flu)
- Diarrhea (even as a side effect of antibiotics)
- Vomiting
- Ringworm
- Chicken Pox
- Hand Foot Mouth Disease
- Mumps
- Impetigo
- Pink eye (or any discharge from eye)
- Head Lice or Scabies
- Measles

If your child is experiencing any symptoms during his/her visit, you will be paged immediately. Your child may return to Kids Korner when he/she is no longer contagious (usually 24 hours after the symptoms are completely gone or 24-48 hours after antibiotics have begun.)
